Learn about a **clinical research study** evaluating an oral investigational medication for people living with HIV-1.



Why Participate?

If you qualify and decide to participate:

- Participation is voluntary, and you are free to withdraw at any time. Your privacy will be maintained throughout the study
- There is no cost to participate, and you will receive all study medications and study-related doctor visits for 2 years at no charge
- Your HIV and overall health will be closely monitored by an experienced HIV study team
- Your participation may help advance medical knowledge about HIV and may help others

Additional potential risks and benefits of participation will be fully described by your study team.

You may be eligible to join the study if you are at least 18 years of age, and you **have been diagnosed with but not treated for** HIV-1 infection, meaning you have received 10 days or fewer of antiretroviral therapy (ART) since your diagnosis (use of PrEP treatment may be permitted). The study doctor and staff can provide you with information about requirements for participation.
